

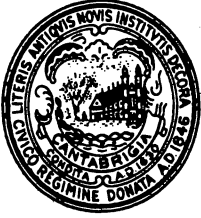

To the Honorable, the City Council:


The attached appropriation transfer in the amount of \$350,000 from C.O.M.A. Salaries and Wages to C.O.M.A. Other Ordinary Maintenance is required to provide payment to C.E.O.C. for wages and/or allowances to approximately 500 economically disadvantaged Cambridge residents who receive services through one of the several employment and training activities, i.e. Job Factory, OJT, Adult Basic Education, etc.

C.E.O.C. is a contracting agent with the C.O.M.A. office and the budgetary system requires payment from Other Ordinary Maintenance because relationship between C.E.O.C. and C.O.M.A. is a contractual one.

This transfer does not reflect any changes in City's manpower programs or funding. It is solely for the purpose of conforming to the Commonwealth's standards for municipal accounting.

Passage of the attached order is recommended.
