- WHEREAS: The "Loaves and Fishes" meal program at Pilgrim Congressional Church at 35 Magazine Street now feeds close to a hundred and fifty hungry and homeless people every Saturday night; and
- WHEREAS: A "Have a Heart for the Hungry" pancake breakfast, featuring Soshana Parkciarz of Project Bread/Walk for Hunger as speaker, will be held at Pilgrim Congregational Church on Saturday, February 10, 1990 at 9:30 AM to educate the Cambridge community about the Loaves and Fishes program and to raise funds for it; and
- WHEREAS: Since 1987, the Loaves and Fishes program has helped to fulfill a pressing need in Cambridge for meal programs for the homeless and pay those whose budget does not stretch far enough to pay for adequate food; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council hereby congratulates and thanks Pilgrim Congregational Church and the Loaves and Fishes meal program for their service to the community over the years and urges Cambridge citizens to support the program by attending the "Have A Heart" breakfast on February 10th.
