

DIVISION 1 - GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

Section 1A - Invitation for Bids

The City of Cambridge, Massachusetts, acting through its City Manager, will receive sealed bids for Roof Repairs and Certain Related Work at the Rindge Field Shelter, Rindge Avenue at N.E. Fitzgerald School, Cambridge, Massachusetts.

Bids will be received at the office of the Purchasing Agent, City Hall, Cambridge, Massachusetts.

Bids from General Contractors will be received until 2:00 P.M., Eastern Daylight Savings Time on Tuesday, 22 October, 1974.

Bids from Subcontractors on certain trades or items of work as required by subsequent portions of this Specification will be received until 2:00 P.M., Eastern Standard Time on Tuesday, 29 October 1974.

All bids will be immediately opened and publicly read aloud at the times and place designated above.

Contract documents, including plans and specifications, will be available at the office of the Purchasing Agent, City Hall, Cambridge, and may be obtained by depositing \$10.00 for each copy. Deposits for documents shall be returned upon receipt of the documents in usable condition within 20 days after the general bid opening. Documents so issued shall be limited to two (2) sets for each general bidder and one (1) set for each sub-bidder. Additional sets may be purchased at cost by bidders desiring to do so. Proposal forms will be issued without cost or deposit in such quantities as bidders require.

Section 1A -- con't

Bid deposits shall be filed by General Bidders in the amount of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00).

Bid deposits shall be filed by Filed Subbidders as listed below:

Bids will be received and the contract awarded in accordance with the provisions of Sections 44A through 44L of Chapter 149 of the General Laws of the Commonwealth as most recently amended.

The City reserves the right to request from any bidder, any information which it deems necessary concerning the bidder's financial conditions, business history, personnel, etc. between taking bids and awarding a contract or contracts.

The right is reserved by the City of Cambridge, Massachusetts, to reject any or all general bids, if it be in the public interest to do so, and/or to reject any sub-bid on any sub-trade, if it determines that such sub-bid does not represent the sub-bid of a person competent to perform the work as specified or that less than three (3) such sub-bids were received and that the prices are not reasonable for acceptance without further competition.
