

City of Cambridge

An Ordinance
relating to the collection of taxes.

Be it ordained by the City Council
of the City of Cambridge as follows -

1. Every person who shall pay his tax to the collector of taxes on or before the tenth day of September, next after the same was assessed on him shall be entitled to a discount of ~~five~~ five per cent on the amount thereof - which discount the collector is hereby authorized to make.

2. Every person who shall pay his tax to the collector on or before the tenth day of October next after the same was assessed on him, shall be entitled to a discount of four per cent on the amount thereof, which discount the collector is hereby authorized to make.

3. Every person who shall not pay his tax to the collector on or before the tenth day of October next after the

Same was assessed - shall pay interest
at the rate of six per cent ~~per~~ a year
on the amount of such tax, ^{from} ~~and~~
^{said tenth day of October and -}
It shall be the duty of the collector to
add such interest to the amount of
the tax and account for the same
to the Treasurer.

4 - From and after the first Monday of
April next the City Treasurer shall
be and ~~is~~ officer collector of taxes
and as such shall have all the powers
and perform all the duties pertaining
to that office and as Treasurer & collector
he shall receive a salary of ~~seven~~^{ten} hun-
dred dollars payable quarterly
