

In Metropolitan District Commission
Boston, Mass., August 9, 1962

ORDERED that on petition of Cambridge Electric Light Company dated June 29, 1962, for locations shown on plans of Cambridge Electric Light Company dated April 28, 1962, and indexed accession numbers 40565X, 40566X, 40567X, 40568X and 40569X, for underground conduits, cables, electric manholes with drain connections and other appurtenances, for the distribution of electricity, under, along and across portions of Concord Avenue and Alewife Brook Parkway in the City of Cambridge, said Concord Avenue and Alewife Brook Parkway being under the care and control of this Commission, said locations having been found by order of the Department of Public Utilities to be required by public convenience and necessity, said plans and petition being on file in the office of this Commission, a hearing on said petition having been given by this Commission on Thursday, August 9, 1962, at 2 P.M., at the office of the Commission in Boston, of which hearing due notice was given to all persons interested of the time and place by publishing a copy of said petition and the order of notice issued thereon by this Commission in a newspaper published in the City of Cambridge, being the city in which the locations petitioned for would lie, the first publication having been made at least fourteen days prior to the date of said hearing, and it appearing, in the opinion of this Commission that public convenience and necessity so require, said Cambridge Electric Light Company is hereby granted locations for underground conduits, cables, electric manholes with drain connections and other appurtenances, under, along and across said Concord Avenue and Alewife Brook Parkway, to the extent and upon the terms, conditions and obligations hereinafter specified, it being understood that such conduits and facilities shall be subject to relocation if and when a reconstruction of the roadway may require such

relocation, the same being such as the public necessity and a due regard for the rights of the Commonwealth require, namely:

1. The Cambridge Electric Light Company shall conform to all provisions of law applicable to the exercise of the rights and performance of the work under this grant and to the rules and regulations of the Metropolitan District Commission.

2. The Cambridge Electric Light Company shall do the work of installing said underground conduits, cables, electric manholes with drain connections and other appurtenances, in the locations hereby granted subject to the approval of the Director of Park Engineering of the Commission as to time, manner and location and in all other respects.

3. Said Cambridge Electric Light Company shall indemnify and save harmless the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and the Metropolitan District Commission from any damage it or they may sustain or be required to pay arising out of the exercise by said Company of the rights hereby granted or by reason of any negligence of said Company or any of its employees in connection with the work done hereunder.

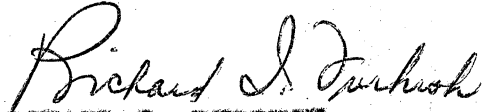
4. Said Cambridge Electric Light Company shall protect and maintain all trees, drainage or water pipes, and all appurtenances or structures either above or below the surface of the ground over which this location lies, and upon completion of the work shall restore the surface of the ground to the condition in which it was at the time of this grant and in a manner satisfactory to said Director of Park Engineering of the Commission, and shall maintain the surface of the ground and the location throughout in such condition to the satisfaction of said Director.

5. The Cambridge Electric Light Company shall place and maintain proper barriers at all times and from the beginning of twilight through the

whole of every night sufficient lights to protect the public from injury or damage during the progress of the work under this grant or during repairs upon said underground conduits, cables, electric manholes with drain connections and other appurtenances, and work on the location which may hereafter become necessary.

6. No work shall be done under this grant without first obtaining a permit therefor from said Director of Park Engineering and subject to conditions imposed by him.

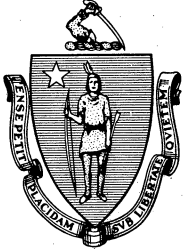
