OBITUARY RELEASE: Sister Annette M. Caron

A Mass of Christian Burial was celebrated on June 22, 2001 in the Chapel at Youville Place, Lexington, MA for Sister Annette Caron, SGM (84). She died suddenly June 20, 2001 at Somerville Hospital, Somerville, MA. Reverend James O'Donohoe, chaplain celebrated the Eucharistic Celebration. The internment took place at Holy Cross Cemetery, Malden, MA.

Sister Annette was born in Salem, MA where she was baptized and educated. Sister Annette entered the Sisters of Charity of Montreal, "Grey Nuns" in Cambridge, MA where she received her religious formation and pronounced her vows as a Grey Nun February 15, 1944. Sister Annette leaves three sisters: Mrs. Louise Sullivan, Mrs. Toni Simmons, and Mrs. Bertha Higgins. As a Grey Nun, Sister Annette was a bookkeeper and served in a variety of administrative positions; Provincial Treasurer, Secretary and Councilor; and Administrator of Planning and Development, Building and Grounds.

We are grateful to Sister Annette for her life of dedication, predominately in health care where she advocated for the poor and those who suffered from illness. She was President/CEO at Youville Hospital, Cambridge, MA for 21 years before retiring in 1989. Sister Annette's administrative abilities are well known by all those who have expressed their tremendous respect for her over the years. During her 57 years as a faithful religious woman, Sister Annette loved life, was a woman of deep faith and a true follower of St. Marguerite d'Youville, foundress of the "Grey Nuns."
