WHEREAS: **Caroline B. Butler** of Cambridge will celebrate her 100th birthday on August 6, 1997; and

WHEREAS: Caroline was born on Prospect Street in 1897, the daughter of the late Matthew and Elizabeth Gannon Butler. Also, Caroline is the niece of the late Rev. Msgr. John A. Butler, former pastor of St. Patrick's, Blessed Sacrament, and St. Mary's Churches; and

WHEREAS: Mary was the granddaughter of Patrick Butler (emigrated from Waterford to Cambridge ca. 1846), Mary Kerwin (emigrated from Kilkenney to Cambridge ca. 1848), Thomas Gannon (emigrated from Kildare to Cambridge ca. 1840) and Ann McAvoy (emigrated from Kildare to Cambridge ca. 1848); and

WHEREAS: Caroline attended St. Mary's Parochial School - 1912, St. Mary's High School - 1916, Lowell Normal School diploma - 1917, and Boston College evening School A.B. - 1935; and

WHEREAS: Caroline taught 4th grade at the Thorndike School 1917 - 1967. Also, Caroline was among the first women to vote - for School Committee in 1918 and, in general elections after women's suffrage in 1920; and

WHEREAS: Caroline taught religious education at St. Mary's for ten years and for forty years at Sacred Heart Parish, Watertown; and

WHEREAS: Caroline is the aunt of seven, grand aunt of twenty-three, and great grand aunt of sixteen; and

WHEREAS: Caroline continues to live her long and happy life in the City of Cambridge; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this Cambridge City Council go on record as congratulating
Caroline B. Butler on her 100th birthday celebration; and be it further
