That, in accordance with the provisions of an ordinance relative to placing and maintaining signs, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to Riverside Cambridgeport Community Corp., for the erection of a ~~sign~~^{fire escape} at 215, 217, 219 Auburn Street.

Provided that, before erecting the above named sign, the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Building Department and file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Twelve-thousand dollars (\$12,000) conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said ~~sign~~^{fire escape}.

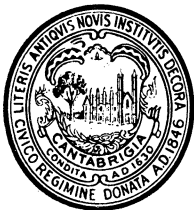
