- WHEREAS: On March 29, the more than 1,370,000 members who belong to over 7,300 councils in the United States, Canada, Mexico, the Philippines, Puerto Rico, Guam, Guatemala, Cuba, Canal Zone, Virgin Islands and Dominican Republic will observe the anniversary of the granting of the Charter; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That in tribute to the record of the Knights of Columbus on behalf of Country, Church, Community and fellowmen and in recognition of its contributions in the field of religion, social welfare, civic involvement, youth work and patriotic endeavor, this City Council go on record as proclaiming March 29, 1983 as "Knights of Columbus Day" in the City of Cambridge; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the Knights of Columbus on behalf of the entire City Council.
