WHEREAS: This road race represents a major community effort to raise funds for homeless families with children and individuals to secure safe, warm, permanent housing; and

WHEREAS: This year's road race themed "Run To House The Homeless", under the auspices of Recreation Director Paul Ryder and Coordinator of Emergency Services Philip Mangano, demonstrates the deep-rooted commitment of the City of Cambridge to address the concerns of those in need; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record urging all Cambridge citizens to take cognizance of and participate in this worthwhile endeavor; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution for presentation to the Committee and sponsors on behalf of the entire City Council.
