IN CITY COUNCIL

November 14, 1988

- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that Cambridge native and Massachusetts State Trooper Brian O'Hare was placed in serious danger on Saturday, November 12, 1988 while in the performance of his duty; and
- WHEREAS: Brian observed two motor vehicles operating in an erratic manner in Bolton, Massachusetts, and stopped these vehicles and proceeded to ask for driver's identification; and
- WHEREAS: Upon being told by the operator of the second motor vehicle he did not have a license, Trooper O'Hare observed that the operator kept his hands out of sight, at which time when Trooper O'Hare requested the operator to remove his hands, the operator produced a .25 calibre weapon; and
- WHEREAS: Instinctively, the Trooper drew his service revolver and immediately ordered the operator out of the vehicle and placed him under arrest while ordering the remaining five occupants in the two vehicles to remain seated; and
- WHEREAS: Trooper O'Hare, for a period of time, was in severe personal danger, since he was without the assistance of other law enforcement personnel, and at any time could have been fatally wounded by one or more of the occupants of these vehicles; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record congratulating State Trooper Brian O'Hare for his bravery and dedication to the law enforcement community; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to State Trooper Brian O'Hare on behalf of the entire City Council.
