~~Ordered~~, Whereas a Private way in Ward Two, called Hastings Street, has heretofore been dedicated to the public use by the owners of adjoining lands, and is now in a fit condition to become a public highway; and

Whereas it is adjudged by the Mayor and Aldermen that the public necessity and convenience require that said street be laid out as a public highway, and that no persons will be damaged thereby, or be entitled to any compensation from the City, therefore

Ordered, That said private way be and hereby is laid out and established as a public highway, by the name of Chatham Street, agreeably to a Plan thereof, drawn by Alex. Wadsworth, bearing date Aug. 10. 1858, a Copy of which Plan is now before this Board. to wit from Dana Street to Cotton Street, the same to be forty feet in width, as delineated on said Plan.
