ORDERED:

That in accordance with the provisions of the General Ordinances of the City of Cambridge, Chapter Three, Section 3-2, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to the First Parish Unitarian Church in Cambridge for the purpose of conducting the Harvard Square Marketplace to be held commencing immediately, on Saturdays from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., until October 31, 1984, for the purpose of displaying and selling merchandise on the sidewalks abutting the Church at the corner of Church Street and Massachusetts Avenue, provided that no such permit shall be granted to exceed more than twenty-five percent of the width of the sidewalk from the property line of the premises in front of which said display shall be installed and provided that further before erecting the above named display, the petitioner shall file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.) conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said display.
