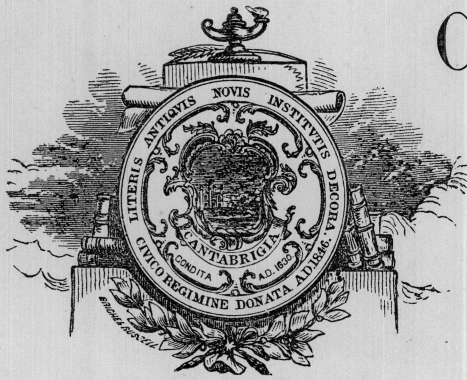




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

IN BOARD OF ALDERMEN,

May 21 1873

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

*Trowbridge Street
between Harvard St. and Broadway*

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land
in width between

Forty feet

Harvard Street and Broadway

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by

Barbour and Hodges, dated February 1873,

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid.

*And that thirty days be allowed for the
removal of all fences or other obstructions standing
on the land so taken*
