The Committee on Roads & Bridges would submit the following report on the petition of Horace Hews that that Western Avenue, between Howard & Putnam Sts, may be filled up to the full width of sixty six feet. They find that the filling asked for would require a large outlay of money and, as public travel is well accommodated with the present width of roadway, as the abutting land is not required for purposes of immediate improvement, and as other portions of the City require more immediate attention, your committee would recommend that no further action be taken at the present time, and that the petitioners be granted leave to withdraw.
