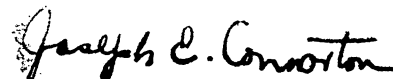

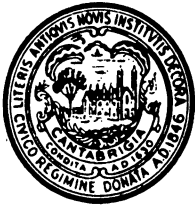

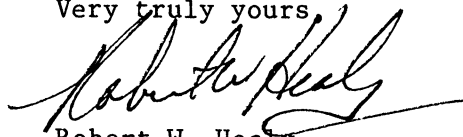
The Honorable, The City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of \$39,200 to the grant fund from Attorney General James Shannon's Office to the License Commission Salaries & Wages Account \$2,220 and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account \$36,980 to provide funds for expanding the scope of jurisdiction of the Cambridge Consumer Council to include the Cities of Boston and Watertown.

The additional funds will be used to hire one full time person and one part time person on contract and expand the use of college work study students as mediators. This additional staff will enhance the services now rendered to Cambridge residents.

Also, this additional appropriation will now make the Cambridge Consumer Council the largest local office in the Commonwealth.
