RE: Petition for Independent Environmental & Traffic Studies at & Surrounding the W.R. Grace Site in North Cambridge, Permit Moratorium at the Site Until Those Studies Are Completed, and Brief Historical Background of the Site for Inclusion in the Consent Communication Agenda for the City Council Meeting on June 24, 1996.

Dear City Council Members:

Attached for your review and further City Council action is a petition signed by almost 600 citizens primarily from the North Cambridge Community. The petitioners are requesting independent environmental & traffic studies at & surrounding the W.R. Grace Site in North Cambridge, and a permit moratorium at the site until those studies have been completed. The specific language of the petition is also attached. A brief historical background of the site is provided below.

The North Cambridge Community and the Community at large have raised a number of legitimate environmental and traffic issue concerns regarding any proposed development at the W.R. Grace Site in North Cambridge. The proposed development area has served for decades as a disposal site for **manufacturing processes** and **chemical wastes** from what has been one of the largest chemical producers in the country. To date there has been virtually no site cleanup. The **roadways** in the immediate vicinity of the site serve as a main access point for vehicular traffic entering the Cambridge/Boston area from the **west**, and a secondary access point for vehicular traffic entering from the **north**.

Although the City of Cambridge has hired respected groups to do PAPER REVIEWS of the environmental and traffic data already compiled by agents of the owner/developer, these reviews **do not** include either an actual independent soil & ground water sampling report or an independent traffic study. It must be emphasized that to date, the only traffic studies or actual soil and ground water samplings have been those generated through agencies hired by the owners/developers of the property. These reports **minimize** the environmental and traffic impact that any proposed development will have on the North Cambridge Community and the Community at large. The history of the site, the site's location, the history of other W.R. Grace Sites around the State, and common sense strongly indicate the contrary.


The City Council has already commenced preliminary action regarding an independent environmental assessment of Russell Field through Council Order #53 dated April 22, 1996. To date, however, no action plan has been initiated in this regard. The attached petition serves to both broaden & accelerate the initiatives set forth in that Council Order.

If we can be of further assistance in accomplishing the goals as set forth in the attached petition, please do not hesitate to contact us.

In so far as repeated requests from the Community for independent verifications of owner/developer financed data studies concerning environmental & traffic issues at the W.R. Grace Site in North Cambridge have met with stiff resistance from the owner/developer, and are apparently a low priority with other City agencies, the petitioners attached to this cover sheet respectfully request that the Cambridge City Council direct the City Manager to accomplish the following:

1) Independent Soil Sampling and Ground Water Study. Hire an agent or agents to conduct an independent, objective, comprehensive and thorough soil sampling and ground water study on publicly owned property surrounding the Grace Site (e.g., State & MBTA land, MDC land, Municipal property such as Russell Field, etc.), and, if legally permissible, on the Grace Site itself. This study should also define the environmental impact that the proposed Grace Site development will have, both short and long term, on the North Cambridge Community and the Community at large.

2) Independent Traffic Study. Hire an agent or agents to conduct an independent, objective, comprehensive and thorough traffic study defining the impact on traffic that the proposed W.R. Grace Site development will have, both short and long term, on the North Cambridge Community and the Community at large.

3) Formal City Council Approval. In order to ensure objectivity, it is further requested that the agent or agents hired by the City have had no prior financial dealings with the City, or the owners and developers of the W.R. Grace Site. Whereas these independent studies will require City of Cambridge financing, it is requested that the specific agent or agents hired receive the formal approval of the Cambridge City Council.

4) Permit Moratorium. Finally, it is requested that NO permits be considered for development at the W.R. Grace Site in North Cambridge by any City agency including, but not limited to, the Planning Board, Zoning Board, Conservation Commission, and etc., until the independent traffic and environmental studies have been completed, and the Grace Site Advisory Committee (created by Cambridge City Council Order #15 dated September 18, 1995) has completed its work and submitted its findings and final recommendations.

Survey Design and Distribution

In order to learn more about neighborhood views of development proposed for the Alewife / Grace properties, the Alewife Study Group of North Cambridge designed a self-administered public opinion survey of about 23 questions. A cover letter described the developer's proposal as was current at that time; it included a "super" supermarket, retail stores, a 750-car parking lot, and (in a later phase), a 150,000 sq ft four story hotel.

In February of 1996 the Study Group mailed the survey questionnaire to 2,750 households in North Cambridge. 150 questionnaires were returned completed. This report is a brief summary of the main findings of this survey.

Characteristics of the Respondents

Of the 150 respondents, 86 respondents chose to identify themselves by name and address; the remainder chose anonymity. Nearly all of the 150 respondents chose to provide some personal background information as requested. This personal information discloses that:

- 39% of the respondents (the "newcomers") have lived in North Cambridge 5 years or less, and 57% (the "oldtimers"), 6 years or more. Almost half the respondents have lived in the area more than 10 years.
- Just less than two-thirds of the respondents are **owners** of their residences, while slightly more than one-third are **tenants**. And,
- Just less than two-thirds (the "**non-participants**") have been to no meetings on the issue of Alewife development, but slightly more than a third (the "**participants**") have been to at least one meeting; 19% (29 respondents) have been to at least three meetings on the topic.

Concerns

Regarding various attributes of the proposed development, about 85% expressed strong or moderate concern about vehicular traffic and parking; other traffic (pedestrian, cyclist); and hazardous waste at the site. A somewhat lesser level of concern was expressed about size and type of stores (79% "strong" or "moderate" concern), and location of stores (75%).

Oldtimers and participants were somewhat more likely to express strong concerns; newcomers and non-participants were somewhat less likely to express strong concerns.

Anticipation of Impacts

In terms of the proposed development's **impacts on crime**, 57% of the 150 respondents felt that the development would increase crime in the area; 8% anticipated a decrease of crime; and 28% thought crime would stay the same. Non-participants were somewhat less fearful of crime impacts (51% thought crime would increase), and newcomers were significantly less fearful of more crime (only 45% thought crime would increase, while 38% thought it would stay the same).

For **impacts on property values**, 19% of all respondents thought that the proposed development would increase property values; 43% expected a decrease; and 30% anticipated no change in property values as a result of the development. On average, non-participants (32%) were less fearful of a decline of property values, and participants (62%) more fearful. Both newcomers (24%) and tenants (25%) were more inclined to expect an increase in property values

due to the development. Owners, oldtimers and non-participants were all somewhat more likely than average to expect no impacts on property values.

Regarding **overall quality of life** in the community, about two-thirds of the respondents agreed that quality of life would likely decrease as result of the proposed development; 21% expected no change, and 10% expected an increase. Newcomers and non-participants were somewhat more likely to expect an increase in quality of life; oldtimers and participants were more likely to fear a change for the worse.

Preferences for Development

Overall, 106 (71%) of the 150 respondents thought that proceeding with the Alewife development project as **currently proposed** (and as described in the survey) is "somewhat" or "extremely" **undesirable**. An even larger number, 78%, was opposed to an office park alternative. More acceptable development patterns included:

- continue as a **flood plain** — 77% said this was "somewhat" or "extremely" **desirable**;
- **landscaped open space** — 76%;
- **athletic uses** — 72%.

Respondents were mixed 50/50 on the subject of limiting the project to a **small neighborhood market**: 70 said yea, 70 said nay to this idea. And support was divided for a "**smaller**" version of the proposal including stores — 39% found this idea at least somewhat desirable, and 57%, at least somewhat undesirable.

Newcomers and non-participants were slightly less opposed to proceeding with current proposal than respondents as a whole.

Summary

In general, owners, oldtimers and participants were somewhat more concerned about possible problems, more given to expecting negative impacts, and more hostile to the proposed Alewife development than the group of respondents overall. Tenants tended to reflect more closely the views of respondents as a whole.

Additionally, it's informative to divide respondents into two camps: (1) the 106 **basically opposed** respondents who state that the current proposal (as described in the survey) is somewhat or extremely *undesirable*; and (2) the 34 **basically sympathetic** respondents who state that the current proposal is somewhat or extremely desirable.

- Not surprisingly, the 106 **basically opposed** tended to be highly worried about specific issues (e.g., 95% expressed moderate or great concern about traffic and parking). They also were highly likely to expect negative impacts: 68% felt crime would increase, 56% felt property values would decrease, and 83% thought quality of life would decrease. This group strongly favored continuation of the parcel as a flood plain (88%), landscaped open space (80%), and/or athletic uses (75%). The basically opposed had little interest in a smaller version of the current proposal, and even less interest in an office park.

- The 34 **basically sympathetic**, of course, are significantly less concerned about potential issues (e.g., only 50% held traffic and parking in moderate to great concern). They were also unlikely to forecast trouble: 76% said crime would remain the same or decrease; 82% said that quality of life would remain the same or increase; and 100% (!) agreed that property values would be stable or would rise as a result of the proposed development.
However, the project-sympathetic respondents were NOT opposed to all possible alternatives: for the project area, 56% ALSO favored landscaped open space, and two-thirds favored either a smaller project, or athletic uses. In other words, even those people ready to say OK to the developer's proposal might welcome mitigations including lower density or more open space. Like those in opposition, the basically sympathetic were not much attracted to the office park idea.

Dear North Cambridge Neighbor:

Since August 1995, the Alewife Study Group, a group of North Cambridge neighbors, has held monthly community meetings at various locations to elicit community opinion and provide information updates related to the proposed shopping center/hotel development. The attached North Cambridge Neighborhood Survey is an extension of our efforts to give voice to members of the community.

Survey Purpose

There are approximately 4000 residences in the North Cambridge area. Perhaps you have been among the nearly 200 people who have attended the monthly community meetings since August. Or, perhaps you have wanted to attend, but were unable because of work and family commitments. Your participation in this survey will enable us to get in touch with a wider group of neighbors in order to more accurately and fairly represent the opinions of the community.

Survey Benefits

The construction of a large-scale retail development in a densely populated area such as North Cambridge should be planned and executed with the utmost care and consideration for the needs and concerns of the community. Without a survey, or other systematic method of collecting information, the developer cannot be expected to represent the needs and concerns of our community. We intend to provide the developer, the City Council, and the community at large with the results from this survey.

The Proposed Development

According to developer Spaulding and Slye's current plans, the proposed development on the W.R. Grace site would consist of a 60,000 sq. ft. superstore, a 750-car parking lot, and 90,000 sq. ft. of retail stores. The second phase of planned development is a 150,000 sq. ft. four-story hotel with underground parking for 65 cars. The total area of the current proposal is 300,000 sq. ft.. (This does not include the existing office building of 87,000 sq. ft.. Total site development as currently proposed would be 387,000 sq. ft..)

We hope you will take a few minutes to complete this survey. The results will be tabulated as rapidly as possible in order to better inform the developer, City Council, and the community. Thank you for your time. We look forward to hearing from you.

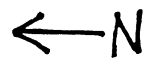
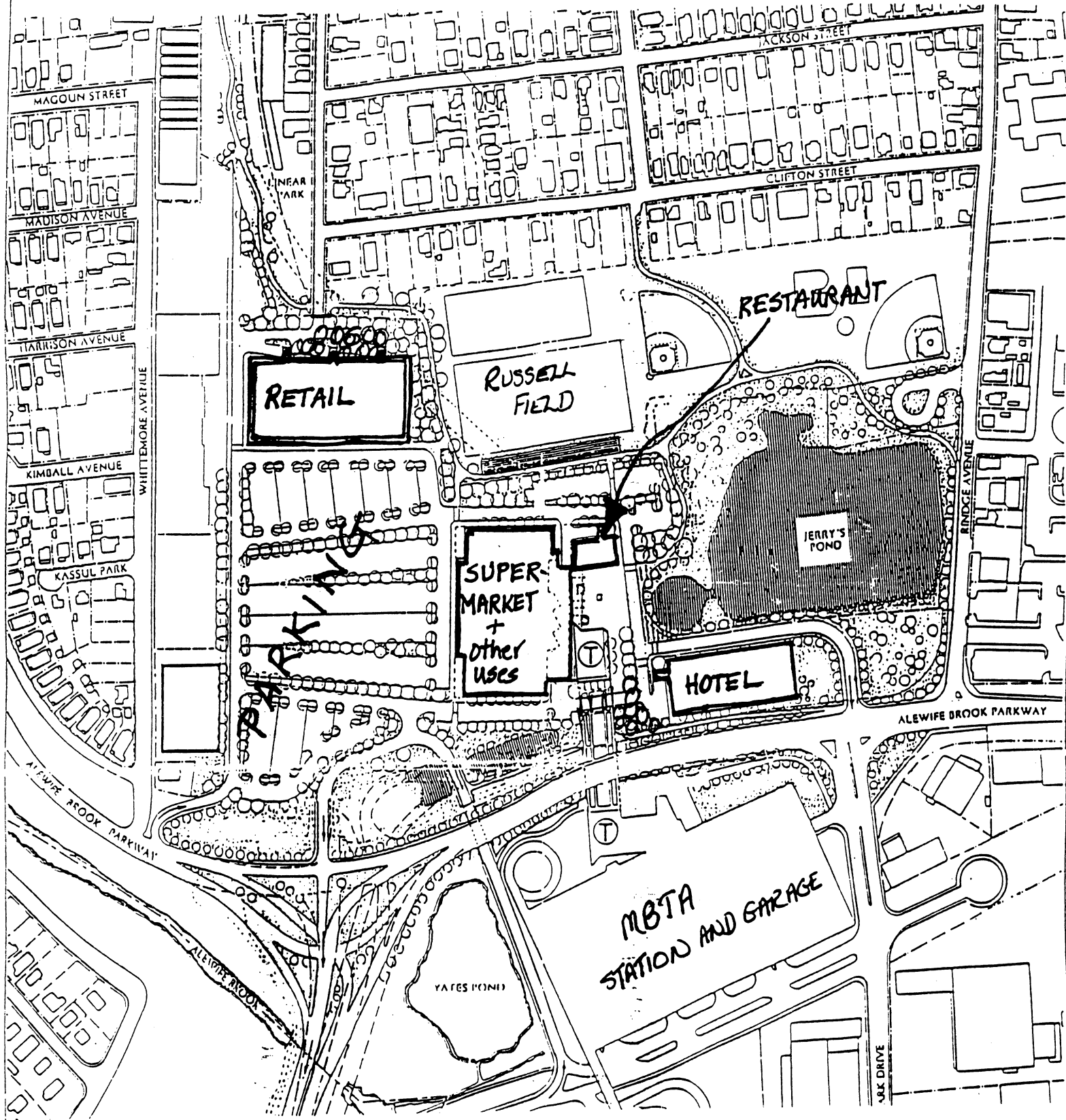

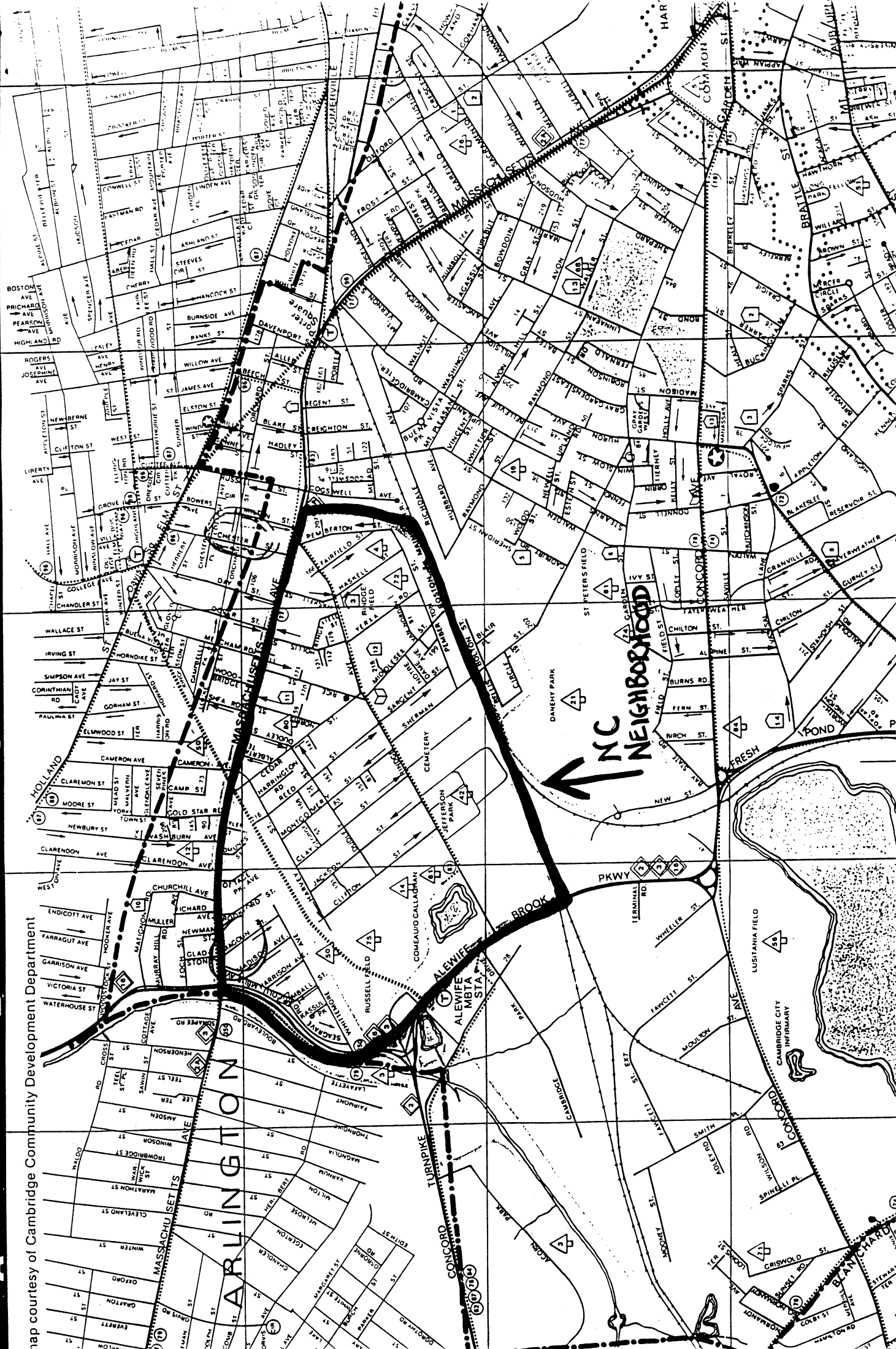
