SUBJECT: **Hate Crimes Investigation**

Sir:

"Hate Crime" is the common term for federal and state civil rights violations. Hate crimes include any crimes principally motivated by hatred of another because of race, color, religion, national origin, sexual orientation, or disability. In Massachusetts, so called "hate crimes" are codified in the Massachusetts General Laws under chapter 265 § 37 and § 39. Hate crimes may occur in murder, non negligent manslaughter, forcible rape, aggravated assault, simple assault, intimidation, robbery, burglary, larceny, motor vehicle theft, arson, and malicious destruction of property.

Every investigative principle that is used in the daily business of the police department also pertains to the investigation of hate crimes. Naturally, given the wide variety of crimes that may be motivated by hate, investigative techniques and resources will vary depending on the circumstances. Evidence of bias motivation may be readily apparent or not. Investigators consider various evidence in determining whether an act was a hate crime including the use of particular signs, symbols or words, whether the victim's group (*race, religion, national origin, sexual orientation, disability*) has been subjected to prior acts of a similar nature, whether there are neighborhood or inter-group problems, whether the victim has been associated with high profile public activities, whether the incident indicates possible involvement by an organized hate group. If the investigation shows bias motivation by the offender than additional complaints for civil rights violations will be brought, in addition to charges for the underlying crime.

Also, if circumstances dictate, investigators may ask the prosecutors to seek a civil injunction against an offender. Such an injunction can curb the behavior of the offender and make any future infraction a felony offense. Lastly, if there are widely felt repercussions from a particular hate crime, or series of events, the Community Relations Section and Operations Division may be called upon to provide both information and a physical presence and reassurance to any neighborhood or community affected by hate crime.

Hate Crimes

"Hate Crime" is the common term for federal and state Civil Rights Violations. Hate crimes include any crimes principally motivated by hatred of another because of race, religion, ethnicity, sexual orientation, handicap status, or gender. *All hate crimes would still be crimes even if the bias motivation were absent*; therefore, each hate crime listed below is also tallied elsewhere in this report.

In 2001, 9 crimes were reported in Cambridge that could be classified as a "hate crimes":

1. Late on a January evening two suspects banged on the window of a Tibetan restaurant. When the owner came out, the second suspect stated "why don't you go back to your own country and punched him in the mouth. This case is still under investigation.
2. This incident in April involved a suspect calling numerous times to the victim making derogatory racial remarks over the telephone. A trace was put on the phone, the suspect discovered, and a court hearing was held.
3. In July, an unknown suspect kicked the victim from behind. The victim was riding his scooter at the time of the assault. Suspect kicked the victim again and Stated "Chinese boy why don't you go home."
4. Unknown suspects fashioned a KKK hood out of paper and left it in front of the victim's hotel room.
5. In late September, a storeowner found a note on the door to his establishment stating, "Latinos get out of Boston."
6. In an incident very similar to the previous crime, a storeowner found a note stating, "Latinos get out of Boston." Both cases were referred to court and cleared.
7. Four suspects approached the victim and started to throw rocks at him. They then began to call him "faggot" and other derogatory names. Several other anti-gay remarks were uttered. The victim was hit with several rocks.
8. Late on the afternoon of November 17th, 2001, the suspect approached the victim and her children and shouted, "go back to Afghanistan you bitch," the suspect then attempted to punch the victim in the face.

9. On December 7th, 2001, at 10:20PM, two suspects approached the victim and stated, "that they hate white girls." The suspects then hit the victim in the head with the board. The suspects were arrested and a court hearing was held.

The Hate Crimes Statistics Act of 1990 was enacted on April 23rd 1990, requiring the Attorney General to collect data on crimes exhibiting racial, ethnic, religious, or sexual prejudice. It was not until September of 1994 that the Act was amended to include biased acts against those with either physical or mental disabilities. The 1999 Uniform Crime Report reveals that there were as many as 7,876 incidents, reported to the FBI in 1999 that categorized as hate crimes. A small portion of these incidents (0.2%, or 19, in total) was disability-related, while the majority of them were race-oriented (56.3%, or 4,295, in total). Religion-oriented hate crimes were measured at 16.5% (1,411, in total), and Ethnic hate crimes at 10.9% (829, in total). Hate crimes based on Sexual Orientation were quoted at 16.0% (1,317 incidents), while Multiple-Bias incidents came
