- WHEREAS: Edward was called President Ronald Reagan's favorite Democratic Governor and offered his congratulations to Edward when he switched to the Republican Party in 1985; and
- WHEREAS: Edward strongly promoted economic growth, was seen as a friend to both labor and management and saw job creation as the primary engine for social as well as economic progress; and
- WHEREAS: Edward's passing will leave a void in the lives of all his surviving family, his sons Timothy and Brian; his sisters Helen and Mary; and his five grandchildren; and
- WHEREAS: Edward will be sorely missed by all he touched and loved; now therefore be it
