- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of Miss Elizabeth Butler, a life long Cantabrigian and retired Director of Primary Education and Kindergarten for the Cambridge School Department; and
- WHEREAS: Miss Butler was a graduate of the Lowell Normal School and Harvard University in 1929, receiving her master's degree, doing further graduate work at Boston University and Boston College; and
- WHEREAS: Miss Butler, in addition to her duties in the School Department, where she was a pioneer in early educational programs for children, she served on the faculty of Regis College for nearly a decade; and
- WHEREAS: Miss Butler was also very active with several charitable groups, including a mission support organization called Sen Fu and the Youville Guild at the Youville Hospital; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending it's deep sympathy to Miss Caroline Butler and the entire Butler family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Miss Caroline Butler on behalf of the entire City Council.
