IN CITY COUNCIL

February 25, 1974

ORDERED:

That the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to the Majerian Development Corp. of 2331 Mass. Avenue, Cambridge to erect a barricade on the sidewalk on Concord Avenue starting at the corner of Moulton Street and going easterly for a distance of 175 feet for a period of six months commencing March 6, 1974 during the construction of a foundation and the construction of a building.

Said permit to be subject to the following conditions:

1. A barricade constructed of chain-link 8 feet high with a sturdy wooden roof to be erected in the public way suitably lighted as to prevent any injury to vehicles and pedestrians using this street during the construction period.
2. Said obstruction to occupy the entire sidewalk at said premises as outlined above.
3. The contractor to restore existing sidewalk to the condition it was prior to the construction or to a better condition.
4. That no existing travel lanes or parking spaces be closed until authorized by the Director of Traffic and Parking.
5. That the contractor shall obtain a Temporary Street construction permit in addition to all other permits required by the City of Cambridge.
6. That the conditions having specified shall be subject to the approval of the Director of Traffic and Parking of the City of Cambridge, he may as he deems necessary, require traffic controls or the use of policemen to facilitate the flow of traffic.
7. The contractor to file with the City Clerk a bond in the sum of \$10,000.00 indemnifying the City of Cambridge from any liability that may arise from the construction of said barricade during the period of construction.
