ON THE TABLE

Councillor Sullivan submitted a motion to take from the table an order exempting the members of the Rent Control Board from the prohibition of Chapter 268a, the Conflict of Interest Law and said motion carried.

That the members of the Cambridge Rent Control Board as Special Municipal Employees be and hereby are exempt from the prohibition of Chapter 268A (so - called Conflict of Interest Law.)

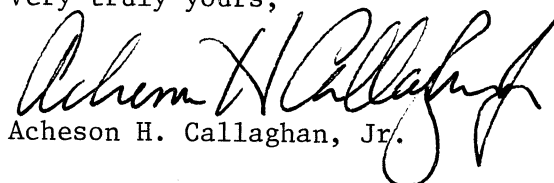

Dear Mr. Healy:

I am writing with respect to my position as Chairman of the Rent Control Board. I understand that members of the Rent Control Board have been classified as special municipal employees under G.L. c. 268A by a vote of the City Council dated June 26, 1972. I further understand that my law firm may be retained from time to time to act as bond counsel for the City of Cambridge. On the assumption that G.L. c. 268A, §20 applies in this situation, I believe it is appropriate to disclose my interest in any such contract. Under our partnership agreement my share in the net earnings of the firm is 3.60 percent.
