- WHEREAS: In 1994, Just A Start was awarded one out of thirty-one implementation awards in a nationwide competition by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the YouthBuild Program for training unemployed youth and young adults; and
- WHEREAS: In the first YouthBuild Program, Just A Start is providing job training, leadership development and education program services for fifty young people; and has rehabilitated one empty, first time home buyer unit and has five more units under construction, all being affordable housing; and
- WHEREAS: On Friday, June 23, 1995, Just A Start was notified by HUD that it has been selected for YouthBuild II for 1996, one of seventy-two implementation awards out of five hundred and forty applications nationwide; and
- WHEREAS: Just A Start will train and educate fifty more unemployed youth and rehabilitate six affordable housing units in YouthBuild II; and
- WHEREAS: Just A Start recognizes the long term, consistent support of its training, housing rehabilitation, and affordable ownership and rental housing development and community building work by the City of Cambridge and the Cambridge Community Development Department; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this Cambridge City Council expresses its pride and support of Just A Start's accomplishments and our gratitude for its commitment to serve urban youth of our nation.
