- WHEREAS: The Commonwealth of Massachusetts owes substantial amounts of money to The Cambridge Hospital whose depth of operational debt continues to grow; and
- WHEREAS: An accurate prognosis of the future fiscal situation at The Cambridge Hospital demands that this Council have in its possession the most up to date data; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That, by March 27, 1989, the City Manager provide this Council with a specifically detailed breakdown of precisely how much the Commonwealth owes The Cambridge Hospital, in what areas it owes it, if it intends to pay it and, if so, when and how; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager invite an appropriate representative from the Commonwealth to appear before this Council to respond to inquiries from the Council members regarding issues raised in this order and allied issues as soon as is possible, but definitely prior to the upcoming budgetary hearings for the hospital's FY 1990 budget.
