That it appears by a reference to the Deed of Edmund T. Dana to the City of Cambridge, conveying "Dana Square", that it is therein required as one of the conditions of the gift, that the city "shall maintain a suitable fence around the same" A copy of the clause in said Deed, relating to "Dana Square", the same being duly attested by the City Clerk, is transmitted herewith for the information of the City Council.

In view of the provision in said deed, hereinbefore mentioned, Your committee reports herewith the accompanying order for the construction of an iron fence around said square, and recommends its adoption as a substitute for the order for removal, as previously reported.

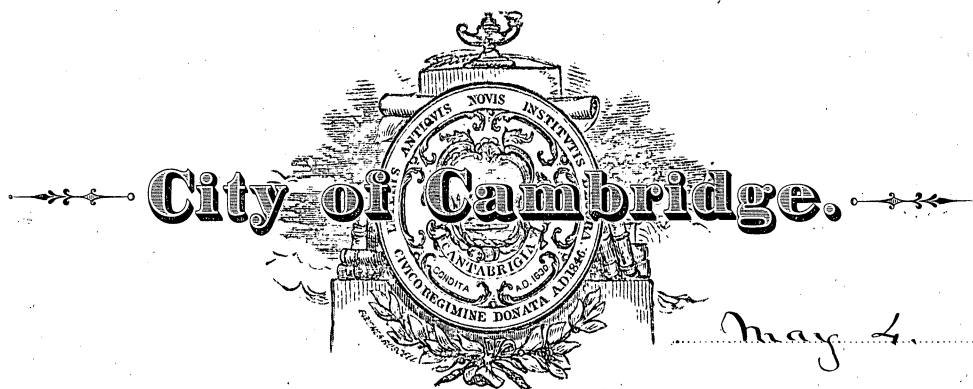

The Deed of Edmund J. Dana to the City of Cambridge, conveying "Dana Square", is dated December 3, 1853, and is on file in the City Treasurer's office.

It contains the following clause:-

"And this conveyance is on the conditions following, to wit:- That the said parcel of land shall be forever kept open, and in good order, as a public square; that the grantees shall cause the same to be properly graded, and shall always maintain a suitable fence around the same; that proper and convenient walks shall be laid out and finished, and always preserved thereon; that the streets on the three last named sides of the said parcel of land shall be properly graded, with suitable sidewalks, and that trees shall be planted and preserved and continued on the outside of the four sidewalks enclosing the said square. And that all of the said conditions which, from their nature, can at present be performed, shall be performed within one year from the date of this deed."
