WHEREAS: Pauline had few affiliations to large organizations and preferred to present herself as the one-woman "Coalition of Angry Old Ladies," although her vision was ageless; and

WHEREAS: Pauline is missed by her special friend Virginia Diggdon and many other friends and neighbors, all of whom will miss her warmth, wit and gentle encouragement for us all to lead the best lives we can; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to the friends of **Pauline Swift** at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
