I thought you would be interested in seeing the enclosed letter I received today from NASA respecting the possibility of naming the Cambridge facility for the late General Eisenhower.

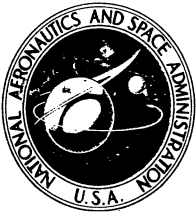
