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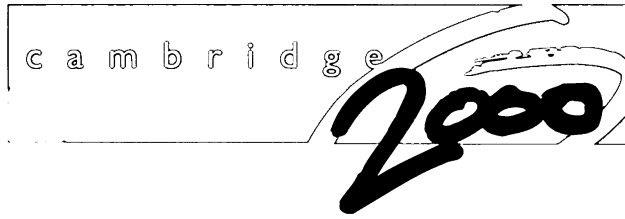

I am hereby requesting an appropriation of \$715,500 to the Public Investment Fund Community Development Extraordinary Expenditures Account.
