Dear Mayor Russell and Members of the City Council:

On Wednesday, August 15, members of the Community Development Department will be asking you to vote to accept various parcels of property being given to the City by landowners abutting Rindge Avenue Extension. This will allow the road to be rebuilt as a tree-lined, four lane boulevard with ten foot sidewalks on each side. The design of the road is a result of collaboration between the Community Development Department, the Department of Public Works, and Spaulding & Slye as managing partner for Triangle Park Associates, which is developing CambridgePark. As you may recall, we had hoped for federal grant assistance in developing the road. Failing that, Triangle Park Associates is paying the full cost of reconstructing the road, as well as the cost of placing telephone and electric wires underground, for a total cost of approximately \$1,000,000.

The CambridgePark project brings to fruition the initial stages of redevelopment of the Alewife Triangle, as envisioned in the Alewife Revitalization Plan. With this letter I am sending each of you a copy of our project brochure for your perusal. At this time we are requesting that you consider renaming Rindge Avenue Extension. We have submitted to the City Clerk a petition signed by ourselves and several other property owners on Rindge Avenue Extension requesting that the street be renamed "CambridgePark Drive". This new name is consistent with the character of our project, and the character of the master plan for the area, described in the Alewife Revitalization Plan. It will provide a new, recognizable name for the Triangle, which should assist us and neighboring property owners as we work toward the goals already set by the city.

We look forward to meeting with you on Wednesday night.
