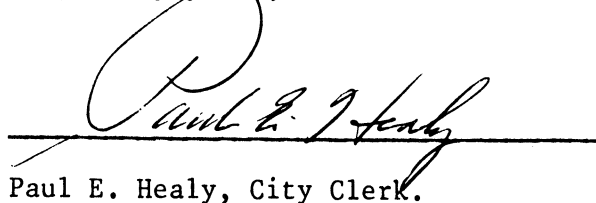

May 16, 1983

- WHEREAS: The easy availability of handguns presents an unnecessary opportunity for violent crimes and tragic accidents; and
- WHEREAS: Snub-nosed handguns, with a barrel length of less than three inches are the most consealable weapons preferred by criminals, but have no legitimate role in sports, hunting, or target practice; and
- WHEREAS: Senate Bill No. 1276, to prohibit the distribution and sale of snub-nosed handguns in Massachusetts, will soon be coming before the state Senate; and
- WHEREAS: This City Council endorsed Senate Bill No. 914 of 1982, the predecessor of this bill, by unanimously adopting Order No. 5 of April 8, 1982; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council memorialize the Senate of the Commonwealth to act favorably on Senate Bill No. 1276; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk immediately transmit copies of this resolution to the Clerk of the Senate and to Senators Bachrach and LoPresti.

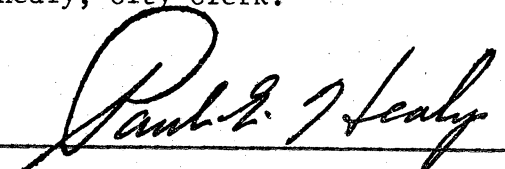
