IN CITY COUNCIL

October 16, 1972

- WHEREAS:- The City Council of the City of Cambridge in regular session assesbled on the sixth day of March, 1972, by rising unanimous vote, extended its sympathy to John M. Gairachty's wife Dorothy, and to his sister and children on learning of his passing on February 10, 1972, and
- WHEREAS:- The City Council in the same vote requested the Community Schools Commission to consider the establishment of some permanent suitable memorial in the name of John M. Gairachty, and
- WHEREAS:- The City Council has received recommendations for such a memorial, now therefor be it
- RESOLVED: That the recommendations of the Community Schools be adopted, namely
1. That the week October 15 through 21, 1972 be declared Community Schools Week, and
 2. That a permanent plaque to the memory of John M. Gairachty be placed in the City Hall of the City of Cambridge, Massachusetts with appropriate ceremonies on Sunday, October 15, 1972, and
 3. That a paperback book collection be conducted in each community School Library, and
 4. That the separate resolutions of Community Schools on these events be adopted and made a matter of record in the City of Cambridge.
