Corporate Purposes

10. To establish the principle of cooperative management of its programs inasmuch as all members shall be required to bear equal responsibility, through participation in the various governing and operating bodies of the corporation as described or authorized by these By-Laws, for the efficient and creative conduct of the affairs of the corporation and its programs.

1. The name by which the corporation shall be known is:

Oxford Street Day Care Cooperative, Inc. ✓

2. The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

1. To design and operate parent-cooperative child care programs.
2. To publicize such programs and encourage their replication by others.
3. To assist in the public definition of the need for child care programs and for free or subsidized access to such programs for all families desiring such services.
4. To assist in the design and implementation of such programs by public and private agencies.
5. To promote changes in work patterns such that working parents can have time free to participate in the daily care of their children.
6. To provide childcare services to low income families at progressive rates.
7. To engage in any lawful activities which may be permitted under Sec. 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 and Ch. 180 of Massachusetts General Laws, each as now in force or hereafter amended.
8. To do everything necessary for the accomplishment and furtherance of the purposes set forth herein.
9. To establish the principle of parent participation in its programs and administration inasmuch as each family shall contribute as much time to the center during each week as the child or children of that family spend in the center during each day; or shall contribute equivalent services as approved by the membership; or shall provide a satisfactory contribution of time through the presence of a surrogate approved by the membership.
