IN THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT PERMITTING THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE TO ESTABLISH PREFERENTIAL RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE RESIDENTS OF THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE FOR PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the City of Cambridge may establish by ordinance preferential residency requirements for residents of the City of Cambridge in the employment of public officials and employees both within and without the classified civil service system.

To the Honorable Senate and House of Representatives of The Commonwealth of Massachusetts
in General Court assembled.

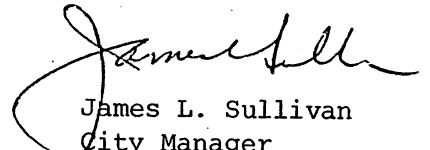

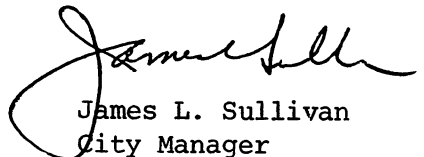
