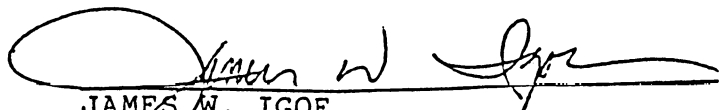

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to M. G. L. c. 30A, s.3, notice is hereby given that the Supervisor of Public Records, Office of the Secretary of State, under the authority of St. 1985 c. 478 and M. G. L. c. 66, ss.1 and 10 will hold a public hearing to receive public comment related to the amendment of 950 Code of Massachusetts Regulations 32.06 of the Public Records Access Regulations. The proposed regulations establish uniform reproduction fees for computer tapes, discs, mailing labels or other automated forms of reproduction of census and voter information contained in the "street lists" compiled by local registrars under G. L. c. 51, ss.6-7. The hearing will be held on Monday, March 10, 1986, in Room 1709, McCormack State Office Building, One Ashburton Place, Boston, MA 02102, from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m., at which time any interested individual may submit data, views or comments concerning the proposed action to the Supervisor of Public Records. Written comments may be submitted to the Supervisor of Public Records until 5:00 p.m. March 10, 1986.

950 CMR: OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF THE COMMONWEALTH

950 CMR 32.06 IS AMENDED BY ADDING THE FOLLOWING NEW SUBSECTION

950 CMR 32.06(6) Street Census Computer Tapes and Mailing Labels Reproduction Fees.

(a) City or town registrars of voters shall provide, or cause their agents to provide, copies of computer tapes containing automated "street list" data collected under M. G. L. c. 51, ss.6-7, for a fee of no more than one cent (\$0.01) per name, provided that a minimum fee of no more than ninety dollars (\$90.00) may be assessed. No fee assessed under 950 CMR 32.06(6)(a) shall exceed seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00).

(b) City or town registrars of voters shall provide, or cause their agents to provide, sets of mailing labels made from computer tapes containing automated "street list" data collected under M. G. L. c. 51, ss.6-7, for a fee of no more than two cents (\$0.02) per label, provided that a minimum fee of no more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) may be assessed.
