

The Cambridge Office of Manpower Affairs has received a grant of \$370,000.00 from the Department of Labor for this year's Summer Youth Employment Program. The attached appropriation order for 1976-77 is based on this grant and will be used to provide short-term, meaningful work experience for six hundred (600) disadvantaged and low-income youth. They will be placed in non-profit City and State agencies for a period of eight weeks (8) at a maximum of twenty-five hours per week. In addition, the program will provide career orientation, tutoring, counseling and other supportive services.
