The proposed widening of Route 2 near the Hobbs Brook Reservoir is of great interest to the people of Cambridge because of possible adverse effects on our drinking water, including pollution by salt and other automobile pollutions, and also because of possible increases of traffic on Route 2, therefore be it

ORDERED:

That the State Department of Public Works consultants on the Route 2 relocation study be requested to make a presentation to the City Council at its regular meeting of March 3, 1975, and be it further

ORDERED:

That the City Manager and the Water Board be requested to attend said meeting, and that the City Manager, prior to the meeting, be requested to propose an appropriate motion for the City Council to adopt on this issue.
