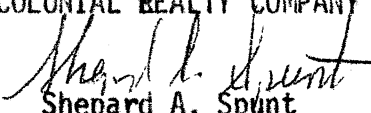
Dear Commissioner: RE: Sidewalk in front of 23-25 ELMER ST.

On behalf of the owner, The Eta Trust, may we respectfully call to your attention the fact that the pavement sidewalk has settled below the level of the curbstone, and therefore in our respectful opinion constitutes a hazard and danger to pedestrians, and most particularly to residents and/or their invitees coming and going to and from subject building from Elmer Street. We are particularly concerned with the potential for example, of a woman catching her heel in the gap between the sidewalk and the curb, and falling down.

As your records will indicate, there have been recent excavations by your department in this immediate area to open the street for access to the manhole, sewer, and other City of Cambridge facilities in the street. Some of this work was done this past winter. The sidewalk appears to have been undermined by the excavations of this past winter, and really need some prompt attention.
