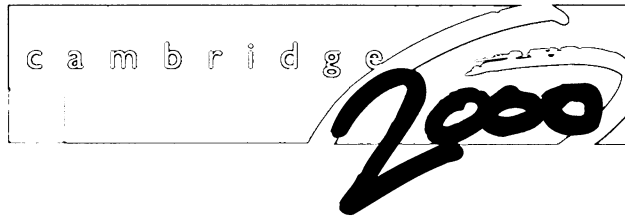

To the Honorable, the City Council:

I am hereby requesting an appropriation of \$1,052,405.00 in the Grant Fund of the Human Services Salary and Wages Account (\$153,124), Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$884,305), and Travel and Training Account (\$14,976). The Federal Government through the Department of Health and Human Services and administrated in Massachusetts by the Commonwealth's Department of Housing and Community Development has awarded funds to the Department of Human Services for the Low Income Heating Assistance Program which services Cambridge and Somerville. The program serves 2,800 clients in both cities and 1,300 of those are Cambridge residents. Eligibility is based on household size, income and where that household falls within the federal poverty guidelines. Benefit levels this year will range from \$100 to \$830 per household.
