Petition of Boston Edison Company for approval by the Department of Public Utilities of borrowings by the Company of not exceeding \$15,000,000 (Fifteen Million Dollars) from the Massachusetts Industrial Finance Agency, the net proceeds of such borrowings to be used for the purpose of refinancing the costs of acquiring, constructing, and installing pollution control facilities at Mystic Generating Station and costs incidental thereto; and for approval by the Department of the issuance of the Company of not exceeding \$15,000,000 principal amount of Series U First Mortgage Bonds to evidence and secure such borrowings.

Upon the foregoing petition, the Department of Public Utilities will conduct a public hearing in its hearing room, #1210, Leverett Saltonstall Building, 100 Cambridge Street, Boston, Massachusetts on Friday, March 9, 1984 at 1:00 o'clock in the afternoon.

The petitioner, Boston Edison Company, is required to give notice of said hearing by publication hereof seven (7) days prior to said date in the Boston Globe, the Boston Herald and the Quincy Patriot Ledger.
