TO ALL PERSONS INTERESTED IN THE PRODUCTION, DISTRIBUTION AND CONSUMPTION OF MILK AND CREAM IN ANY AND ALL OF THE SEVERAL MILK MARKETING AREAS IN THE COMMONWEALTH, AND TO ALL OTHER PERSONS INTERESTED:

Notice is hereby given by the Massachusetts Milk Control Commission that, by virtue of the authority vested in it by General Laws Chapter 94A, and more especially pursuant to the provisions contained in Sections 2,5,9,10,11,16,23,24 and 25 thereof, it will hold a public hearing for all Milk Marketing Areas of the Commonwealth, as follows:

and thereafter at such times and places as the presiding officer may deem necessary for the purpose of receiving from all interested persons testimony and evidence pertinent to the following subjects and issues:

1. Whether or not the town of Warwick currently located in Milk Marketing Area No. 5B should be transferred to Milk Marketing Area No. 7G. Whether or not the town of New Salem currently located in Milk Marketing Area No. 5B should be transferred to Milk Marketing Area No. 9C. Whether or not the town of Ware currently located in Milk Marketing Area No. 5B should be transferred to Milk Marketing Area No. 9E (see Official Orders Nos. G5-006, G7-011 and G9-008).
2. Whether or not the Commission should add Milk Marketing Area Nos. 4 and 5B in Section 1 (1) and (2) of Official Order No. G-022 so that wherever it reads "5A, 6A, 7B, 8, 10C, 12, 13A, 13B, 15, 17 and 17B", it should be amended to read "Milk Marketing Area Nos. 4, 5A, 5B, 6A, 7B, 8, 10C, 12, 13A, 13B, 15, 17 and 17B."
3. Whether or not the Commission should terminate Official Orders Nos. G4-269 and G5-270 fixing prices to be paid to producers in Areas 4 and 5B.
4. Whether or not the Commission should adopt any and if so, what amendment or amendments to Official Order No. GF-203 as most recently amended effective September 1, 1970 in Sections 1, 2 and 3 by adding Milk Marketing Area Nos. 4 and 5B so that it would be amended to read "Milk Marketing Area Nos. 4, 5A, 5B, 6A, 7B, 8, 10C, 12, 13A, 13B, 15, 17 and 17B"; in Section 3 by changing the formula for the computation of the butterfat differential; and in Section 7 thereof to designate the Milk Marketing Area Orders currently in effect.

5. Whether or not the Commission should adopt any and if so, what amendment or amendments to Article IV, Section 3, Paragraph (1) of Official Order No. G-301, as most recently amended by Amendment No. 19, effective September 1, 1970. Said Paragraph (1) contains the formula to determine the price payable to producers for Class II milk sold, distributed, used or disposed of by milk dealers in various pertinent milk marketing areas.

6. Whether or not Article VIII, Section 3 (b) of Official Order No. G-301, as last amended by Amendment No. 19, effective September 1, 1970, should be further amended by changing the factors in the determination of the butterfat differential.

7. Whether or not the Commission should adopt any, and if so, what order or orders or amendments to order or orders relative to the subject matter of Items Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4 & 5.

All persons desiring to be heard or to submit written statements or arguments, or to testify on any subject or matter specified in the hearing notice are hereby notified to appear at the above designated time and place. Copies of all of the above cited Official Orders may be obtained at the Commission's office.
