That the city manager be and hereby is requested to develop a method of informing the city council on a regular basis when new businesses settle in Cambridge and when existing businesses leave the city.

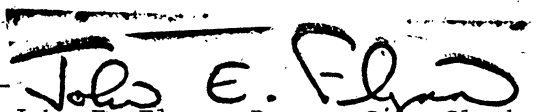
