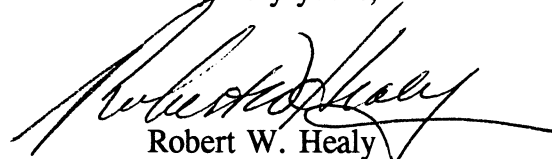

To The Honorable, The City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of \$11,375.00 in donations to the Grant Fund Police Travel & Training Account. Fourteen members of the Cambridge Police Department's Youth Advisory Board, accompanied by four members of the Cambridge Police Department who acted as chaperons, left Cambridge and flew to Miami to attend the Ninth Annual National Youth Crime Prevention Conference. This conference was sponsored by the National Crime Prevention Council and Youth Crime Watch of America and conference is the largest gathering of youth and adults to discuss both reducing youth victimization and engaging youth in crime prevention roles. This year's conference focused on motivating youth and adults and helping them gain skills to expand anti-crime community-building efforts.

The members of the Youth Advisory Board, young men and women from Cambridge ranging in age from 13 to 19, gained valued information at the various workshops which included such topics as *Youth Crime Watch Training*, *Building Bridges Youth-Adult Partnerships*, and *Student Empowerment*.
