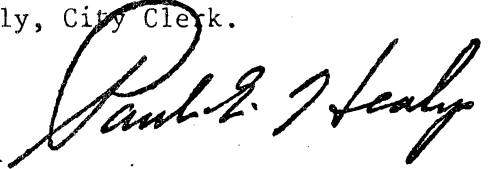
COUNCILLOR CLINTON
