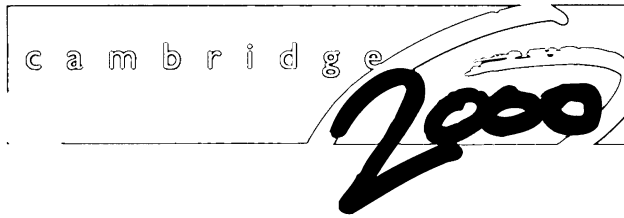

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$115,735.06 from the Massachusetts Highway Department through the Central Artery Force Account Agreement to the Grant Fund Community Development Salaries and Wages account (\$111,735.06), Other Ordinary Maintenance account (\$3,000), and Travel and Training account (\$1,000) to support the City's Central Artery/Tunnel Project Coordinator. The Coordinator monitors Central Artery Construction, coordinates work between City Departments and the Central Artery, and acts a liaison among the City, public, and Central Artery/Tunnel Project staff. Additionally, these funds will support the purchase of a new computer, supplies, and staff training.
