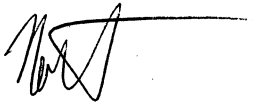
The intersection of Prospect St. and Bishop Allen Drive in Cambridge is in desperate need of a traffic light. It is easily the most dangerous intersection I have ever encountered. There is heavy traffic along Prospect St. approaching and leaving Central Square, and turning left or continuing straight along Bishop Allen Drive is a hair-raising experience. I see a near accident almost every time I drive through there.

I've seen traffic lights at intersections in Cambridge with far less traffic (for example, Granite and Pleasant Streets). Please push for this traffic light at Prospect and Bishop Allen.
