WHEREAS: Walter G. Boudreau was a three sports star at Cambridge High and Latin prior to his enrollment at Boston College where he received national recognition as an outstanding hockey player and as a member of the Sugar Bowl Team of 1940 and the Orange Bowl Team of 1942 prior to his service as a P. T. Boat Commander in the South Pacific in World War II, and

WHEREAS: Walter G. Boudreau compiled an outstanding record as a teacher coach at Rindge Technical School, Mt. St. Charles Academy and Taunton High School prior to his return to Boston College where he served as Executive Director of the Boston College Alumni and as Director of Alumni Placement and has been nominated for membership in the Hall of Fame at Boston College, and

WHEREAS: Walter B. Boudreau was a native son of the University City who strived for perfection in every endeavor and exemplified in his life, the motto of his Alma Mater, "Always to Excel", therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council in session assembled on October 3, 1977 record our deep sorrow at his departure from our midst and extend our condolences to his family and friends, and be it further
