

City of Cambridge.

In the year One Thousand Eight Hundred
and Sixty-seven,

An Ordinance

in further addition to "An Ordinance providing for a division of the City of Cambridge into Five Wards, and for determining the boundaries thereof, and the number of members of the Common Council which each Ward shall be entitled to elect."

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge, as follows:—

Sec. 1. The number of the Wards of the City, for the next five years, shall be five; and the boundaries of the several Wards shall continue the same as now established, [~~except~~ as hereinafter provided.]

[~~Sec. 2. The dividing line between Ward Number One and Ward Number Two shall be a line drawn from Main Street through the center of Dana Street to Broadway; thence, turning a little more Easterly and running through the center of a new street laid out in continuation of Dana Street, to Cam-~~

bridge Street; thence through the centre of Cambridge Street to Line Street; thence through the centre of Line Street to the boundary line between Cambridge and Somerville.]

[Sect. 3. The boundaries of Ward Number Three shall be as follows: Beginning at the water, at the mouth of Beward Canal; thence by the centre of said Canal to Portland Street; thence by the centre of Portland Street to Cambridge Street; thence by the centre of Cambridge Street to the framed junction Railroad; thence by the centre of said Railroad to the boundary line between Cambridge and Somerville; thence by said boundary line to the water of Charles River; thence by the water to the point begun at.]

Sect. ~~4~~². Ward Number One shall elect four members of the Common Council; Ward Number Two shall elect five members of the Common Council; Ward Number Three shall elect five members of the Common Council; Ward Number Four shall elect four members of the Common Council; Ward Number Five shall elect two members of the Common Council.

Sec. 2. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
