- WHEREAS: During snowy weather, unshoveled sidewalks present an inexcusable hazard to pedestrians and a particular danger for our senior citizens; and
- WHEREAS: Violation of snow shoveling regulations is now a non-criminal offense, enabling the city to give warning tickets and subsequently fines to offenders; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby requested to have the Public Works Department vigilantly monitor and ticket residents who do not observe snow shoveling regulations, so that pedestrians of all ages in Cambridge will face one less struggle this winter.
