WHEREAS:

Royal Pease, a former employee of the Public Works Department of the City of Cambridge, entered the service of the Public Works Department on November, 1933 and was pensioned on June 19, 1948 and died on March 10, 1973, having served not less than fourteen years, and

WHEREAS:

At the time of his death said employee had no rights to elect that benefits be paid to his survivor, said employee leaves as his survivor, his widow, Mrs. Carrie Pease, who has not remarried and is not receiving any retirement allowance or pension under the provisions of any general or special law, therefore be it

ORDERED:

That, under the provisions of Section 101 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, Tercentenary Edition, and amendments thereto, that in order to promote the public good, and in consideration of the long and meritorious service performed by Royal Pease, an annuity be granted to Mrs. Carrie Pease, widow of Royal Pease of \$1200.00 per year.

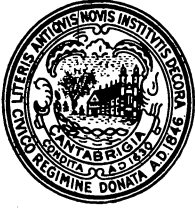

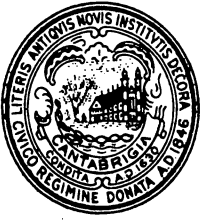


