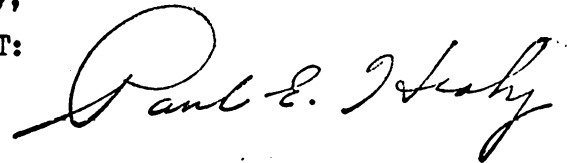

Dear Mr. Healy:

I have viewed the location of the proposed driveway on Berkeley Street at the rear of the Association of Trial Lawyers of America building and recommend that the permit be denied due to the fact that it would not meet the requirements of the Zoning Ordinances specifically, in that, the area between the building and the property line is only 10 feet wide.

The Zoning Ordinance requires that all off-street parking shall be at least 5 feet from any building, property line or street line unless a special permit is granted by the Board of Zoning Appeal.
